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A Pilgrimage to **the Wonders of Peru**

APRIL 05 - 16, 2027

Day by Day Itinerary

April 5, Monday, Day 1: Depart USA

Flights to Lima: Today we depart for our flights to Lima with meals and beverages served aloft. Upon arrival at Lima airport and after visa formalities we are greeted by our TSTC representative and continue to our hotel to check-in and for time to rest.

Overnight: Lima (Dinner, based on arrival)

April 6, Tuesday, Day 2: Lima: City Tour

Our pilgrimage begins with a city tour of Lima, the oldest capital in South America, with a superb combination of Spanish Colonial and 19th century European architecture. Visit the Plaza de Armas of Lima, where we will see the Government and Municipal Palaces. Visit the nearby Lima Cathedral and San Pedro Church. Return to our hotel for overnight.

Overnight: Lima (Breakfast, Lunch)

April 7, Wednesday, Day 3: Lima: Dominican Convent

This morning we visit the Casa de Aliaga, one of the oldest and best-preserved mansions in South America. Continue to the Saint Dominican Convent and pray at the tombs of St. Rose of Lima and St. Martin de Porres. This afternoon, we celebrate mass at the Dominican Convent before returning to our hotel.

Overnight: Lima (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 8, Thursday, Day 4:

Lima: Cerro San Cristobal, Los Descalzos Convent

Following a full breakfast we begin our day by traveling to the top of Cerro San Cristobal for a beautiful view of Lima then head to the Nazarenas Church. Built in 1655, the church was devastated by a massive earthquake, leaving only a mural of the Crucifixion unharmed. Visit the church and celebrate Mass. Continue to Los Descalzos Convent, built in 1595. End our day at the San Franciscan Convent including the basement of bones and Senor de los Milagros en el Santuario de Las Nazarenas de Lima.

Overnight: Lima (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 9, Friday, Day 5: Cuzco: Coricancha Temple

After breakfast, transfer to the airport and take a flight to Cuzco. Upon arrival, you are transferred to your hotel for check-in. In the afternoon, join the orientation tour of Cuzco, the old capital of the Inca Empire. You will start your tour with a visit to the Coricancha, also known as the "Temple of the Sun" the construction of which was ordered by famous Inca Emperor Pachacutec (1438-1471). Temple was used as base for the construction of the Santo Domingo Convent upon the arrival of the Spaniards. Mass celebration will be held at the Santo Domingo Church (Convent).

Overnight: Cuzco (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 10, Saturday, Day 6:

Cuzco: Plaza de Armas, Cuzco Cathedral

This morning after breakfast we move to the south of Cuzco to discover the Andean Baroque Circuit, passing through different small towns and crossing beautiful natural landscapes. 19 kilometers from Cuzco we will find the town of Huasao, known mainly for its tradition of witches or shamans. Later we will stop in the town of Oropesa, famous for making the typical chuta bread. We continue the trip to the Church of San Pedro Apóstol de Andahuayllas. This beautiful temple was built in 1610 probably on an Inca sanctuary. The beauty of its gold leaf framed paintings and ceiling engravings gave it the nickname "America's Sistine Chapel." We continue to the colonial temple of San Juan Bautista de Huaro, built with adobe and simple stone in the second half of the 16th century approximately.

Among the most emblematic works of the site are 'The Holy Family' and 'The Scene of the Last Judgment', which includes Santa Rosa de Lima. At the end of the visit, we return to the city.

This afternoon we walk to the Plaza de Armas for a guided tour in the Cathedral of Cusco, the most important building on the Main Square and the mother church of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Cusco.

Overnight: Cusco (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 11, Sunday, Day 7: Cuzco: Sacred Valley

After breakfast we drive to the Sacred Valley of Incas. Visit a popular religious shrine (Señor de Huanca) and celebrate Mass there. We will visit the historical town of Pisac with its colorful market. Lunch in Pisac. We then head to Ollanta station to take a train to Aguas Calientes which is the gateway city to Machu Picchu.

Overnight: Machu Picchu (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 12, Monday, Day 8: Machu Picchu: Cuzco

After breakfast we will visit one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. The legendary Lost City of Machu Picchu, the most famous archaeological site in all South America, a once-in-a-lifetime experience. Your first view of the ruins really does take your breath away. Enjoy exploring the ancient citadel, its corridors, ceremonial centers, and terraces with its tremendous view across the Urubamba River valley. Free afternoon at leisure before returning to our hotel for overnight.

Overnight: Machu Picchu (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 13, Tuesday, Day 9: Ollantaytambo – Chinchero – Cusco

This morning we board our train to Ollantaytambo. Upon arrival we transfer to the inca town of Chinchero, famous for its local tradition of textiles. We visit a women's cooperative to learn about this important heritage before transferring back to Cusco city. In the evening we have dinner at a local restaurant featuring a Peruvian Folklore Show.

Overnight: Cusco (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 14, Wednesday, Day 10: Cuzco: Fortress of Sacsayhuaman

This morning we take an early train back to Cuzco. Travel to the nearby ruins and the Fortress of Sacsayhuaman and the Cristo Blanco, spectacularly set above the city. We have a late lunch / early dinner before we transfer to the airport for your flights to Lima.

Overnight: Lima (Breakfast)

April 15, Thursday, Day 11: Lima: National Museum

Today we visit the Larco Herrera Archaeological Museum, is considered a must for all editors and travel specialists, and undoubtedly one of the best museums in Latin America. Located in a viceregal mansion from the 18th century, built on a pre-Columbian pyramid from the 7th century, the Larco Museum is surrounded by beautiful gardens. Its new galleries exhibit the best and most complete collection of gold and silver of pre-Columbian Peru in the world, as well as its famous collection of ceramics. After free time for lunch we transfer to the Parks of Miraflores where we have a panoramic tour. We have time for shopping in the Indian Market and then return to our hotel for overnight.

Overnight: Lima (Breakfast)

April 16, Friday Day 12: Return Home

Today we take an early morning flight with memories and keepsakes to last a lifetime.

Terms and Conditions

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Terra Sancta Travel Center shall be referred to as TSTC within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies. Passports must be valid for six months after the date of departure.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by TSTC. A second payment of \$1250 is required on or before 10/05/2026. A third payment of \$1000 is due on or before 01/04/2027. Final payment is due 02/01/2027. Late payments are subject to \$50 late fee. TSTC reserves the right to cancel reservations that are not paid 30 days prior to departure and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after TSTC receives your signed cancellation, TSTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule:

In addition to any fees/penalties assessed by airlines or hotels, the following charges apply:

1) Minimum cancellation fee is \$350 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.

2) From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$350 + 20% of total price.

3) From 59 days to 8 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$350 + 50% of total price.

4) From 7 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

PASSENGER TRAVEL PROTECTION PROGRAM (HIGHLY RECOMMENDED): Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes effect once payment is received. If you chose to purchase outside of the time sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable.

MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our travelers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. TSTC is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior, during, or after travel.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach (air-conditioned).

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge added to the invoice. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost of \$950.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner daily in accordance with itinerary. All other beverages are extra. Dinner on the day of arrival and breakfast on the last day will be included pending final flight schedules and availability.

TIPPING: The price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the Tour Guide and Motor Coach Driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each; Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be precollected before pilgrimage for traveler convenience, but it will be decided as a group closer to departure.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing **non-refundable, non-amenable tickets** for groups flying together for the entire itinerary. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations.

Minimum number of paying passengers is 25.
