# *A Pilgrimage to* **Marian Shrines**

Under the Spiriuual Direction of Fr. Andrew Heintz

**September 07 - 20 2026**

## Day by Day Itinerary

**Day 1 Monday, September 07: Depart USA:** Your pilgrimage begins today as you depart on your flight to Barcelona.

**Day 2 Tuesday, September 08: Arrive Barcelona:** Upon arrival in Barcelona, we are greeted by our Terra Sancta Travel Center Representative and transfer into the capital of Catalonia and transfer to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Overnight: Barcelona (Dinner)**

**Day 3 Wednesday, September 09: Barcelona:** This morning, we will visit the most famous Holy family church, La Sagrada Familia. La Sagrada Familia is an unfinished Catholic Basilica in Barcelona designed by the celebrated Art Nouveau architect Antoni Gaudi. We enjoy a full guided tour of the Basilica before we celebrate Mass. We will then continue to Park Guell before we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Overnight: Barcelona (Breakfast, Dinner)**

**Day 4 Thursday, September 10: Barcelona:** Today we visit Sacred Heart Cathedral and take a tour before celebrating Mass. We then have the afternoon free in Las Ramblas.

**Day 5 Friday, September 11: Montserrat:** This morning we will travel outside of Barcelona to visit the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Montserrat, the spiritual heart of Catalonia and home to a dramatically set Benedictine monastery. For 700 years this Marian shrine has attracted thousands of pilgrims from around the world. We pause here to visit the Black Madonna of Montserrat, probably Spain's most fervent devotion to the Blessed Mother. We continue to Andorra La Vella for dinner and overnight.

**Overnight: Andorra La Vella (Breakfast, Dinner)**

**Day 6 Saturday, September 12: Andorra La Vella/ Lourdes:** This morning in Andorra LaVella we view Romanesque churches and stone houses in the city's quarter, along with a visit to the Shrine of Our Lady of Meritxell. Continue to Lourdes, where we will check into our hotel.

**Overnight: Lourdes (Breakfast, Dinner)**

**Day 7 Sunday, September 13: Lourdes: Grotto of Massabielle, Basilica of St Pius X, Baths:** This day we start with mass at the Grotto of Massabielle, where our Lady appeared to Bernadette in 1858. Later we take our official group photo in front of the Basilica, followed by our guided tour of Lourdes. The sanctuary of the Basilica of St. PiusX, the world's largest underground church. The Basilica, The Baths, where thousands of miraculous cures have taken place is the most respected shrine and sanctuary in France.

**Overnight: Lourdes (Breakfast, Dinner)**

**Day 8 Monday, September 14: Lourdes / Loyola / Santander:** Pyrenees Mountains, Basilica of Loyola: This morning we depart Lourdes and drive through the Pyrenees Mountains of Loyola, the hometown of Saint Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Jesuits. Here you will visit the Basilica and the tower house where he was born and lived. We continue to Santander for dinner and overnight.

**Overnight: Santander (Breakfast, Dinner)**

**Day 9 Tuesday, September 15: Oviedo/ Santiago De Compostela:** Cathedral of Oviedo, Tomb of Asturian Kings, Camara Santa: Depart Santander this morning and drive to Oviedo, the capital of Asturias region. Here we will visit the Cathedral which houses the tombs of Asturian kings and the Camara Santa, a restored 9th century chapel containing expressive statues of Christ and the Apostles. We then head to Santiago de Compostela for dinner and overnight.

**Overnight: Santiago de Compostela (Breakfast, Dinner)**

**Day 10 Wednesday, September 16: Santiago De Compostela:** Santiago De Compostela Cathedral, Crypt of St. James, City Tour: This morning we begin our visit of Santiago de Compostela, one of the most famous shrines in the world, where the tomb of St. James (brother of St. John the Divine) was discovered. St. James was given the task of spreading Christianity in the distant Hispanic lands and is known as the first pilgrim. Since the discovery of the tomb, numerous miracles have taken place here and every year thousands of faithful gather on July 25 to celebrate the Feast Day. We begin with a visit to the Cathedral of St. James, one of the finest examples of architecture in all of Europe. As pilgrims, we have the opportunity to climb the stairs behind the high altar to visit the crypt where the relics of St. James are preserved, touch the central pillar (Portico de La Gloria), view the 'botafumeiro' and admire the wealth of medieval art inside the Cathedral, before visiting the cloister museum. Enjoy a stroll on own, though the beautiful streets of Santiago de Compostela, the city of the apostle, full of historical buildings and others. Dinner and overnight in Santiago de Compostela.

**Optional Morning Walking Tour:** This morning we set out to join the walking pilgrims at the Monte del Gozo from which the spires of the Cathedral are first visible. We will walk the last couple of miles of El Camino arriving at the Cathedral of St. James, the destination we have been yearning to reach. Continue to the Cloister Museum with our group.

**Overnight: Santiago de Compostela (Breakfast, Dinner)**

**Day 11 Thursday, September 17: Santiago De Compostela / Porto/Fatima:** Church of St. Francis: Today we depart Santiago de Compostela and continue to Porto to see the wine factory and enjoy sampling the best wine. We visit the church of St. Francis before driving to Fatima for dinner and overnight.

**Overnight: Fatima (Breakfast, Dinner)**

**Day 12 Friday, September 18: Fatima: Rosary & Candlelight Processional:** This morning we visit Fatima, where Our Blessed Mother visited three shepherd children, Lucia Santos and her cousins Bl. Jacinta & Bl. Francisco Marto in 1917. We participate in the Rosary & Candlelight Procession.


**Overnight: Fatima (Breakfast, Dinner)**

# Terms and Conditions

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Terra Sancta Travel Center shall be referred to as TSTC within this document.

**DOCUMENTS:** US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies. Passports must be valid for six months after the date of departure.

**REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT:** **Non-refundable deposit** of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by TSTC. A second payment of \$1250 is required on or before 04/20/2026. A third payment of \$1000 is due on or before 06/01/2026. Final payment is due 07/13/2026. Late payments are subject to \$50 late fee. TSTC reserves the right to cancel reservations that are not paid 30 days prior to departure and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

**INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS:** Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after TSTC receives your signed cancellation, TSTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule:

In addition to any fees/penalties assessed by airlines or hotels, the following charges apply:

- 1) Minimum cancellation fee is \$350 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.
- 2) From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$350 + 20% of total price.
- 3) From 59 days to 8 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$350 + 50% of total price.
- 4) From 7 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

**PASSENGER TRAVEL PROTECTION PROGRAM (HIGHLY RECOMMENDED):** Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes affect once payment is received. If you chose to purchase outside of the time sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable.

**MEDICAL CONDITION:** We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our travelers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. TSTC is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior, during, or after travel.

**LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS:** By private deluxe motor coach (air-conditioned).

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge added to the invoice. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost of \$999.

**MEALS:** Breakfast and dinner daily in accordance with itinerary. All other beverages are extra. Dinner on the day of arrival and breakfast on the last day will be included pending final flight schedules and availability.

**TIPPING:** The price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the Tour Guide and Motor Coach Driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each; Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be precollected before pilgrimage for traveler convenience, but it will be decided as a group closer to departure.

**AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH:** Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing **non-refundable, non-amenable tickets** for groups flying together for the entire itinerary. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

**SEAT ASSIGNMENT: THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES.** Note that "bulkhead" and "exit row" seats are assigned by the carrier at the airport. TSTC can not guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. Though not guaranteed, early check-in is recommended to secure seats with travel companion.

**BAGGAGE:** International flights to and from the USA allow the passenger to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations.

**PRICES:** All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at time of quotation and based on minimum number of paying passengers stated in the brochure, and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if group does not reach minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate. Minimum number of paying passengers is 25.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Passport and Visas, meals not mentioned, beverages with meals, extra beyond standard menu, excess baggage, luggage on domestic flights, telephone calls, fuel surcharges increase, portorage at the airports, gratuities for drivers, local guides, tour escorts and hotels' staff.
